

RESOLUTION OF THE EASTERN NAVAJO AGENCY COUNCIL

Supporting and Endorsing the Completion of a Rural Addressing System and the Development and Implementation of a Navajo Nation Enhanced Emergency 9-1-1 System

WHEREAS:

1. The Eastern Navajo Agency Council is a recognized governing entity of the Navajo Nation comprised of 31 Chapters, located within the boundaries of the Navajo Nation. It is endowed with perennial responsibilities to advocate for its citizens and communities within the Eastern Navajo Agency confines; and
2. The Eastern Navajo Agency Council is aware of the need for a Navajo Nation-wide Enhanced Emergency 9-1-1 System for any sudden occurrences of emergencies, and recognizes the lack of an effective emergency response; and
3. The Eastern Navajo Agency Council acknowledges the need for establishment of an Enhanced Emergency 9-1-1 System on the Navajo Nation, to improve adequate communications and expedite emergency services; and
4. Furthermore, the Eastern Navajo Agency Council genuinely believes those communities within Eastern Navajo Agency will not only benefit the people, but also public businesses, health care facilities, educational institutions, fire districts, emergency rescue personnel and police districts.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

1. The Eastern Navajo Agency Council hereby respectfully submits its support and endorsement in the implementation of a Rural Addressing System, and subsequently, a Navajo Nation Enhanced Emergency 9-1-1 System, an effort by and through the Communications and Utilities Department of the Navajo Nation Division of General Services.
