RESOLUTION OF THE FORT DEFIANCE AGENCY COUNCIL

The Fort Defiance Agency Council Supporting and Endorsing the Completion of a Rural Addressing Systems, the Development and Implementation of Navajo Nation Enhanced 911 System Through the Efforts of the Utilities and Communities of the Navajo Nation Division of General Services.

WHEREAS:

1. The Fort Defiance Agency Council is comprised of twenty-seven (27) chapters in the Fort Defiance Agency; and
2. The Navajo Nation Chapters are certified Chapters of the Navajo Nation pursuant to 2 N.N.C. § 4001 and 11 N.N.C. Part 1 § 10 having the authority to address and explore the local needs and concerns of chapter residents through participation in community planning; and
3. The Fort Defiance Agency Council supports the re-establishment of the Rural Addressing System for the Navajo Nation and District 17 Chapters throughout the Navajo Nation; and
4. The Fort Defiance Agency Council supports the establishment of an Enhanced 911 System for all community members and is aware of the need for such a system for sudden occurrences of emergencies and also recognizes the need for a quick effective response to these emergencies; and
5. Furthermore, the Fort Defiance Agency Council genuinely believes that the communities will greatly benefit, along with businesses, schools, and governmental entities.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

1. The Fort Defiance Agency Council hereby supports and endorses the implementation of a rural addressing system and subsequently, an enhanced 911 System through the efforts of Utilities and Communications of the Navajo Nation Division of General Services.
